The Deer Tribe Gun Club members here in Phoenix (many of whom participated in multiple “Handgunner” matches) revived it in 2009, refined it in 2010, relived it in 2011., and are recapturing the magic in 2012. An 8 stage version of this great match. 2 classes, open and limited. USPSA, IDPA, ICORE, SASS, there’s room for all and all are welcome. At the end of the day, we will take the top 8 from each class and shoot them off in a grand finale to determine the overall champion. Prizes will be awarded by random draw.
